Program Objectives

The above objectives can be accomplished by the following:

Bible

- Use of the schools "Faith Alive" curriculum for daily devotions, along with puppets, posters and flannel board
- Teach simple songs and prayers

Colors and Shapes

- Recognition taught through songs, posters and hands on activities such as playdough, crafts, books, blocks and puzzles.

Numbers

- Recognition of numbers, counting using fingers and objects. Through songs, daily calendar, books, puzzles and using flannel graphs

Reading Readiness

- Recognize first and last name. Child's nametags and labeled cubbies.
- Tell simple stories. Sequence from first to last, left to right.

Music

- Listen to simple songs. Dancing, singing and rhythm instruments
- Listen to music on tape.
